Warehouse Survey Program

Curtiss-Wright's field service professionals conduct thorough, on-site warehouse surveys to identify and catalog warehouse items. We follow a proven process to identify gaskets, packing, O-rings, and other sealing products.

One of the major challenges utilities face is stock inventory accuracy. They may know a part fits specific equipment in their plant, and not realize its compatibility with multiple pieces of equipment across their plant and fleet.

Curtiss-Wright's Seal ID Stock Identification Software Program, is a web-based database housing all the information captured during a warehouse survey, along with Curtiss-Wright's full description of exactly what the item is, not just what were it goes or what it does. Searches can be performed by the CAT ID or Stock Code (SKU), or by OEM and OEM Part Number. Seal ID provides existing CAT ID description, material(s) found during the survey or upgraded/changed to, OEM information, part number, material, and a picture of the part.

The Seal ID Program provides a complete list of duplicate items linked to multiple CAT ID's or Stock Codes (SKU), allowing the customer to consolidate and manage inventory effectively across the entire fleet. The software will provide a standardized product description, flag and eliminate duplicate items, aggregate like parts and material(s) for standardization, and streamline warehousing. Seal ID gives the utility a true picture of their inventory and arms the end user with the proper information to make accurate cost-saving decisions.
